

Chapter 105

FIREWORKS

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Common Council of the City of Buffalo City 6-13-1968 by Ord. No. 58. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 105-1. Unlawful acts.

It is unlawful for any person to sell, expose or offer for sale, use, keep, discharge or explode any firecrackers, or any fireworks on land belonging to the City of Buffalo City, or any of its streets, and waterfront.

§ 105-2. Permitted uses.

Nothing herein contained shall prohibit the use of fireworks for pyrotechnic displays given by public authorities or civic organizations.

§ 105-3. Violations and penalties. ¹

Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$500, and, on default of payment of such forfeiture, shall be imprisoned not less than 30 days nor more than six months. Any day such violation continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
