Recreation – Meier to coordinate cement with LaDuke for the new swing set in park and take out old this spring.

Building – Three Permits issued. One project needs a letter to get a permit. Waiting to get a permit application for a replacement shed on Front Street property.

Health & Safety – Johnasen said he will be working on getting property owner on Schiller to clean up. Would like clerk to send a letter outlining what must be done with a deadline and clearly stating fines will be issued after the date. Lorenz said there are other properties that should also be warned. Czaplewski is concerned that the garage that burnt on South River Road is still standing as is. Letter will be sent to the property owners.

Riverfront – Meier said docks will be put back in as soon as water is down and it is safe.

BBC – Many sites in county are closed due to Covid-19. Czaplewski said BBC will remain open for now.

Mayor Update – Discussed 2020 insurance policy. Consensus current cyber coverage is enough. Motion Holien, second Mack to approve the 2020 insurance policy with the Municipal Property Insurance Company in the amount of \$10,149. All yes, motion carried.

City Superintendent – Sweeping on south side of City close to being done. Part-time employee has been cleaning cemetery up prepping for spring/Memorial Day.

Clerk – Will need Board of Review members and date/time for May meeting next week.
