

RIVERFRONT COMMITTEE-MONDAY, JUNE 5, 2017-6:00 PM-BUFFALO CITY MUNICIPAL BUILDING

The Buffalo City Riverfront Committee was called to order by Chair Russ Lorenz. Present: Russ Lorenz, Ben Holien, City Superintendent Stan Meier and Clerk Jenny Ehlenfeldt.

The Committee discussed re-inspecting riverfront properties. It was decided to send one more warning letter that re-inspections will take place June 19th due to the high water making it hard to fix up docks. Around 20 letters were sent out in the end of May after initial inspections. About half of those receiving letters have contacted the clerk that they are working on their properties. Clerk to take photos of all properties that were notified in May. Committee will give lease holders until the 19th to get their docks and riverbanks in order. At that time a last warning letter will be sent giving them 10 days to rectify the situation or the lease will be revoked.

Superintendent told to work on getting marking poles replaced. Discussed putting waiting list on City website. Anyone can call and ask the clerk where they are on the list. Committee agreed that is all that is needed. Discussion about a resident parking boat on other's docks. Clerk received a complaint in late May. Letter to resident was returned unclaimed. If more complaints are received the City will try to contact again.
