The Buffalo City Riverfront Committee was called to order by Mayor Russ Lorenz, Present: Jeannie Czaplewski, City Superintendent Stan Meier and Clerk Jenny Ehlenfeldt.

The Committee reviewed the Shoreline Management Plan lease agreement with the U.S. Corps of Engineers. Committee was recently made aware that a transfer of lease with the sale of a commercial property is not covered in the lease agreement. Section added to require the transfer of a riverfront lease with the sale of a commercial property. Other committee recommendations for changes to the plan include: dock size between 3 and 8 feet wide limit, adding wording to take anyone off riverfront waiting list that already has a lease and not allow anyone new to be added to list that already has a leased space, add section to allow committee to split up larger leased spaces that are being transferred per the agreement and increase the permit fees for leases expiring in the 2022 cycle.
