§ 95-1. Discharge restricted. ¹

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or cause the discharge of any missile from any firearm, including air rifles or other weapons, unless express written permission permitting the same shall have been given for a specific purpose and for a specific date, by the City Clerk, with approval by the Mayor or designee.

§ 95-2. Violations and penalties.

Any person violating this chapter shall forfeit to City of Buffalo City a sum not exceeding \$25, and in default of the payment of such forfeiture and the costs of the action for its collection, shall be committed to the county jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 60 days, or until otherwise discharged, pursuant to law.
