The 2nd Regular meeting of the City of Buffalo City Common Council was called to order by Mayor Russ Lorenz at 7:00 p.m. Roll call: Kevin Mack, Ben Holien, Jeanne Czapski and Larry Johansen. Also present City Superintendent Stan Meier. The meeting was held as noticed. Motion Holien, second Johansen to approve minutes from Regular Meeting April 9th. All yes, motion carried.

Health and Safety: Discussion on property safety or health concerns. Mayor will address the concerns. Clerk to attend quarterly County Highway Safety Commission Meeting to discuss speed zone on River Road and ATV use in the City.

Cemetery – Clerk working with the Buffalo County Historical Society to have the City Cemetery mapped using an online mapping service. C-FC FFA is on board to help. City will provide food, refreshments for the group that helps. Mapping tentatively scheduled for Friday, May 18th. Cemetery committee meeting set for Sunday, May 20th at 11 a.m.

Riverfront: Two benches are in the process of being manufactured in memory of Randy Kollmann and David Holien. The Kollmann bench will be placed on the riverfront near the Cove and the Holien bench will be placed near the 2nd Street fishing dock. Clerk working out details with Corps of Engineers. Riverfront committee meeting tentatively set for Monday, May 21 at 5p.m.

Building Committee: Mack is reviewing an application for construction of a detached garage.

Superintendent: Plowing with continued snow. Discussion on getting the county road swept near Cochrane. Johansen said the sand left at the corner going into Cochrane causes problems with kids on bikes during the summer. Meier will work on getting it swept up. Lorenz would like Meier to take an OSHA training class.

Clerk: Interview times will be set up for part-time employee position.
