

**CITY OF BUFFALO CITY 2nd REGULAR MEETING-
MONDAY, APRIL 15, 2019-MUNICIPAL BUILDING – 7:00PM**

The 2nd Regular meeting of the City of Buffalo City Common Council was called to order by Mayor Russ Lorenz at 7:00 p.m. Roll call: Kevin Mack, Ben Holien, Jeanne Czaplewski and Larry Johansen. Also present City Superintendent Stan Meier. Citizens Janet and Lance Laduke. The meeting was held as noticed. Motion Holien, second Mack to approve minutes from Regular Meeting April 8th. All yes, motion carried.

Public Works: Discussed the estimate from Davy engineering to assess the potential flood mitigation options at the north end of Buffalo City. Motion Mack, second Czaplewski to approve the contract for an estimated \$1,500. All yes, motion carried.

Riverfront – Coulee docks will be here tomorrow. Council does not want to see the docks put back in the water yet. Wait for water to level off more. Clerk to put old north dock for sale on facebook.

Citizens: Ladukes addressed the council to discuss the platted street between them and their neighbors. They know their neighbor has been to meetings requesting it be opened. They do not want to see it opened. There is no need. They would like it measured and officially surveyed so there is no argument as to what is for public use. Council told Ladukes there is no reason to open 28th Street at this time. It was platted for future development in the fields behind their homes. It would be a waste of tax payer money to develop and have to maintain. Lorenz told Ladukes there is a chance the county would rework the apron and culvert onto the county road.

Superintendent: The plow broke while plowing Friday. Estimate from Universal to fix was over \$1,000. Meier to look into what a new plow would cost. Will begin sweeping tomorrow.
