

**CITY OF BUFFALO CITY REGULAR MEETING-
MONDAY, DECEMBER 11, 2018-MUNICIPAL BUILDING – 7:00 PM**

The Regular meeting of the City of Buffalo City Common Council was called to order by Mayor Russ Lorenz, Jr. at 7 p.m. Roll call: Kevin Mack, Jeannie Czaplewski, Larry Johansen and Ben Holien. Also present City Superintendent Stan Meier. The meeting was held as noticed. Motion Holien, second Johansen to approve minutes from the previous meeting. All yes, motion carried.

Finance – Motion Mack, second Czaplewski to approve the 2018 Mill Rate at \$21.21/thousand. All yes, motion carried.

Recreation – Skating rink lighting has been upgraded. City crew is trying to get the rink filled and ready for use. Water is continuing to seep into the ground because it is not completely frozen yet. Meier said they will continue to try to slowly layer the ice for the best ice conditions. Lorenz said they would hope to open by Christmas depending on the weather/ice.

Building – No permits issued.

Health & Safety – Johansen received one plowing complaint. Clerk also had one complaint. Clerk gave all council members a copy of the City's snowplowing guidelines so they could use them to address any future calls they may get. Lorenz would also like the guidelines posted on the City's website and at B&S for all residents to see the guidelines have not changed in many years and are being followed.

Fire Board – Mack said no official update. Officer elections were held. All officers will remain the same according to the clerk.

BBC – Czaplewski will be attending another county recycling meeting to represent BBC. Holien informed the board that he will be stepping down from the board after the April election. Lorenz said he will appoint someone new at that time. Discussion on changes being made at BBC. Czaplewski and Holien are hopeful that the changes will be beneficial to all communities.

City Superintendent– Quote for shop doors discussed. Superintendent has been approached by a private citizen about plowing her driveway. Council consensus that no plowing of any private property can be done due to liability concerns.

Mayor – City Superintendent vacation discussed. Council consensus that if he has to plow and can't get it all used by the end of the year they will act on paying his 2018 vacation out at the January meeting.

Clerk – Motion Holien, second Mack to approve the sale of cemetery plot 118 N ½ of N ½ NEW to Julie Anderson. All yes, motion carried.

Motion Holien, second Mack to pay bills. All yes, motion carried. Motion Mack, second Czaplewski to adjourn. All yes, motion carried.
