The City of Buffalo City 2024 Mowing Bid Requests:

- Contractor must possess a certificate of liability with a minimum of \$1 Million coverage. Please include proof of liability coverage with your bid.
- Please make your proposal based on both a per time mow and estimate of seasonal cost based on a 22-week growing season. Include the cost of trimming every other mow.
- Cost should also include picking up branches and garbage before mowing. City will designate an area where these should be left.
- **Attached is a map of the properties to bid as one bid:**
 - Foelsch Park
 - The Old School House Shoppe
 - Lot across from the School House Shoppe (Between 7th & 8th St/Humboldt)
 - 14th St Lot(Between 14th and 15th St on Humboldt)
 - 16th St Lot(Corner of 16th and Humboldt)
- **Include a separate bid to mow the City Cemetery – mowing once per week with trim every other week**
