

**CITY OF BUFFALO CITY
ORDINANCE #2021- 01**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT A NEW WARD PLAN
FOR THE CITY OF BUFFALO CITY, WISCONSIN,
AS REQUIRED UNDER WISCONSIN STATUTES**

**The Common Council of the City of Buffalo City, Buffalo County, State of Wisconsin,
do ordain as follows:**


SECTION 1. Section 211-2 of the Code of Ordinance is created to read as follows:

“Section 211-2 Common Council.


- A. **Creation of Wards.** Pursuant to the provisions of *Wis. Stat. § 5.15*, the City of Buffalo City is divided into two (2) wards, consecutively numbered one through two, from the West end of the corporate limits of the City of Buffalo City to the East end of the corporate limits. The two (2) wards are more specifically described as follows:
- (1) **First Ward.** The following territory shall constitute the First Ward: That area bounded on the East, North, and West by the corporate limits of the City of Buffalo City and on the South by the centerline of West 12th Street, which centerline shall be extended easterly and westerly.
 - (2) **Second Ward.** The following territory shall constitute the Second Ward: That area bounded on the East, South, and West by the corporate limits of the City of Buffalo City and on the North by the centerline of West 12th Street, which centerline shall be extended easterly and westerly.
- B. **Aldermanic Districts.** The City of Buffalo City common council shall consist of four (4) alderpersons elected at large from the City of Buffalo City for terms of two (2) years as provided in *Wis. Stat. § 62.09(5)(a)*. Two (2) alderpersons shall be elected from each of the following two (2) aldermanic districts:
- (1) The following territory shall constitute the First Aldermanic District: The First Ward and the Second Ward, to be elected in even-numbered years.
 - (2) The following territory shall constitute the Second Aldermanic District: The First Ward and the Second Ward, to be elected in odd-numbered years.
- C. **Polling Place.** The wards shall have a common polling place, which is located at 245 East 10th Street, in the City of Buffalo City, Buffalo County, Wisconsin.”

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and publication as provided by law.
