

RIVERFRONT COMMITTEE-WEDNESDAY, MAY 3, 2017-6:00 PM-RIVERFRONT NORTH TO SOUTH

The Buffalo City Riverfront Committee was called to order by Chair Russ Lorenz. Present: Russ Lorenz, Ben Holien, City Superintendent Stan Meier and Clerk Jenny Ehlenfeldt.

The Committee inspected all riverfront leased properties. Letters will be sent to all lease holders who are not in compliance with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Shoreline Management Plan regulations in regards to debris on the riverbank, broken steps and docks. Re-inspection will occur first week of June. Photos of those that did not comply will be taken at that time. Any properties still not complying will be taken back by the City.

Superintendent to replace/fix many poles along the Riverfront.

Discussion of giving out the fire lane areas to those on the waiting list for a space. Committee will bring up to the council.

Meier told to remove the old Buffalo City Bait Shop sign from the riverfront.

Riverfront lease given back on Spring Lake area was cleaned up by Council member. Meier will get debris picked up off the banks.

10th Street Dock was also inspected and several issues found that need repair immediately. Clerk will be submitting an insurance claim for damage caused by ice and wind this winter.

2nd Street Fishing Dock needs signs up. Meier also needs to get chains across openings. Holien and Clerk will work on getting the donation ordered and a dedication set.
